

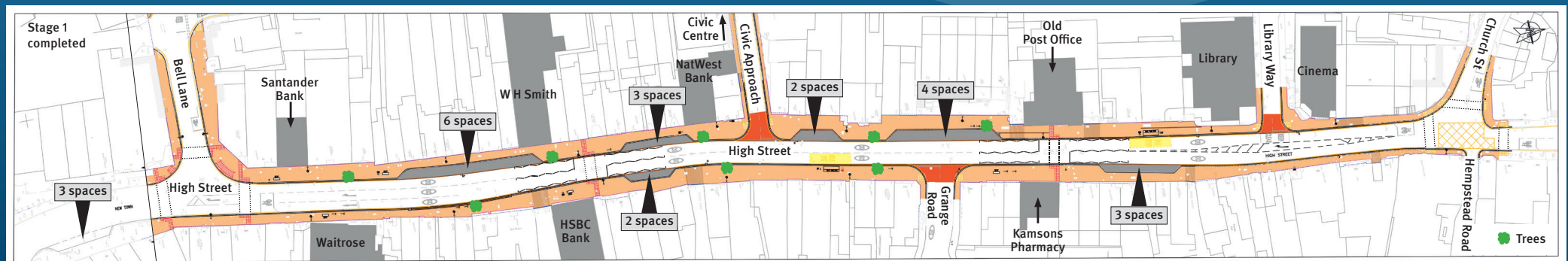
Uckfield Town Centre Improvements update



Uckfield is a vibrant and flourishing town but it suffers from traffic congestion in the High Street. With more housing already being built and further developments planned over the next 15 years this can only get worse.

To be successful, town centre shops and businesses need a good environment and customers able to reach them easily and safely, by car, public transport, by bike or on foot.

This scheme is being funded by developer contributions. If it is not completed as designed the money has to be returned.

Traffic Management solutions

- **One way traffic – 32 week build**
- **Road Closure – 20 week build full closure (24 weeks if closure in two halves allowing Luxford car park to stay open)**

The money for the scheme is not sufficient to fund two other solutions but we have considered them:

- **Shuttle System (traffic controlled by temporary traffic lights) – 52 week build**
- **Night Working – 68 week build**
